Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and name/address
- financial information and investment objectives
- suitability information and investment experience

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons AmericanTCS chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does AmericanTCS protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does AmericanTCS collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you • open an account or transfer an account • update your account or transact in your account • or from your representative regarding your preferences.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • <i>Mid Atlantic Capital Group, Inc.; Mid Atlantic Clearing & Settlement Corporation; Mid Atlantic FinSource 1, LLC, and Mid Atlantic FinSource 2, LLC.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • <i>Our nonaffiliated service providers are obligated to keep the personal information we share with them confidential and use it only to provide services specified by AmericanTCS.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • <i>AmericanTCS does not share personal information with unaffiliated third parties for use in marketing their products or services.</i>
